MMPC-TCCC Provider Course – Tactical Combat Casualty Care (Provider Level 3) CHE.2869.8



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Within the context of the Partnership for Peace programme (PfP), the Swiss Armed Forces International Command SWISSINT represents a Tactical Combat Casualty Care Provider (Level 3) Course to the Military Medical Personnel (As a pre-course of the MMPC CHE.2869.6).

This 5-day training is intended to build up the essential skillset necessary to cope with the care of wounded personnel in combat situations. Through classroom lectures and practical work it prepares you to perform essential tasks and medical procedures.

Additionally all required elementary medical skills will be refreshed. Our training centre staff and military team of experts, as well as specialised trainers will guide you through this comprehensive and challenging course. They will coach and assist you honing key abilities, in order to successfully tackle difficult and potentially life-threatening situations in unstable environments.

In accordance with the TCCC guidelines provided by the United States Department of Defense Committee on Tactical Combat Casualty Care (CoTCCC) you will receive essential tools focused on the most important parts when conducting TCCC related activities.

AIM

On completion of the course, you will:

- Have a comprehensive understanding of the current TCCC guidelines, the various phases of TCCC:
 - Be effective in implementing and executing a basic management plan for care under fire (Phase 1).
 - Be confident and competent to plan, arrange and provide tactical field care (Phase 2).
 - Be able to effectively and competently plan, execute and conduct tactical evacuation care (Phase 3).
 - Be confident in applying first aid measures above the combat threshold in accordance with TCCC principles (Phase 4)

Target Audience / Level The course is designed for military medical personnel (OR4 – OF3) who wish to develop key skills and competencies for future field deployment in potentially hostile Peace Support Operations. Advanced Medical training is highly recommended.

Location SKOPJE, Republic of North Macedonia

Language Requirements Participants must have the following standards of proficiency in English (as described in STANAG 6001): **2221**.

- Listening (Functional / 2)
- Speaking (Functional / 2)
- Reading (Functional / 2)
- Writing (Survival/ 1)

No translation will be provided.

Costs There is no tuition fee for the course. Accommodation, meals and Travel to and back from Skopje are to be paid by the sending Nation. Switzerland may take over the costs upon request.

Restrictions Course is open to NATO/PfP, MD, ICI and Contact States but upon invitation only.

Course participation is limited to 15;
Allocation will be on a "first come – first serve" basis.

Registration deadline: not later than 5 weeks prior to course begin.

Liability The Swiss Armed Forces do not cover health care expenses. All participants are personally responsible for adequate insurance (accident, liability and health) or need a Governmental guarantee to cover any health care expenses in North Macedonia.
