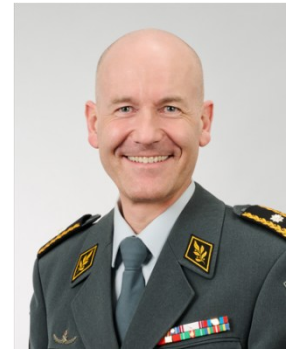




# Brigadier General Dan AESCHBACH
