Short Strategy INCOA

Competence model and Training

- Continuation of international leadership courses at intermediate and advanced levels. Opening of terminology training courses to foreign participants. Creation of new courses based on NATO and partner nations' needs.
- Creation and delivery of the Swiss Armed Forces' Basic Course for interoperability. Start of research work to respond to the NATO EVES policy.

Cooperation and Networking

- Deepening cooperation with personnel-providing nations and creating the necessary foundations for welcoming foreign personnel into Swiss command structures.
- Establishment and implementation of the Governance structure as well as the Academic Council to ensure the implementation of the INCOA at the highest level of NATO's educational framework.
- ♦ Increase Switzerland's active participation in international and multilateral NCO related network to ensure supportive conditions for the long-term work of the INCOA.

Standardization and Innovation

- Development of common doctrinal bases for member nations and partners in order to promote the overall improvement of the non-commissioned officer corps through training programs directly addressing identified needs.
- Creation of holistic training plans based on the most advanced teaching methods and technologies in order to make NCOs force multipliers at all levels.

Communication and Positioning

- Proactive communication to explain the role and functioning of the INCOA within the Swiss Armed Forces to gain the understanding and support of the Swiss military community.
- Promotion within the professional Swiss NCO corps to enhance its appeal and thus ensure participation in courses and the succession plan.
